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By joining the ODRC you are agreeing to comply with our Code of Conduct (as set out below) and any other policies implemented by us for your safety during the year.

## CODE OF CONDUCT

By becoming a member (or if you are a parent/guardian of a child who is a member) of ODRC you have agreed to act in accordance with this Code of Conduct and you have confirmed that you have read and understood that:-

- Horse-riding at any standard has inherent risk and that all horses may react unpredictably on occasions. You accept that you may fall off and could be injured & you accept that risk;
- Instructions are given for your safety and you agree to follow instructions given to you by the committee, their helpers, instructors or landowner appointed by ODRC and you agree to abide by all signs/posters at events;
- Correct hat, body protector and relevant dress code will be required at all shows.
- ODRC will make decisions based on information you give them and you agree to always be honest and volunteer information about (1) your abilities and riding experience, (2) any previous riding accidents and (3) any medical condition(s) which may affect your ability to ride;
- Children are at particular risk around horses and agree that you will keep children that you are responsible for, under close supervision when they are not being instructed by ODRC and agree that any children under the age of 16 will not be left unsupervised at any ODRC event/show ground;
- ODRC may refuse your entry for safety or operational reasons.
- Competing carries enhanced risk over and above general riding and you agree that if you chose to participate in any competition or event, it is up to you to ensure that you have the experience and ability to ride the course including any jumps which form part of it. If you are in any doubt, you will use your judgment and experience and not enter;
- Any unreasonable, anti-social, abusive or aggressive behaviour towards the committee, ODRC members or anyone else attending ODRC events will NOT be tolerated and any persons acting in such a manner will **HAVE** to leave the event/show ground.
- **No horses left tied-up unattended outside of vehicles.**
- **Miss-treatment** of horses will not be tolerated.
- **AS A MEMBER WE ASK THAT YOU HELP SET UP, STEWARD ON SHOW DAY OR CLEAR AWAY AT 1 OR 2 SHOWS. WITH OUT HELP THESE SHOWS CAN NOT RUN.**

## First Aid & Accident Reporting

- Any accidents/injuries or incidents **MUST** be reported to a member of the committee OR First Responders and **MUST** be recorded in the Accident/Incident Book as soon after the accident/incident as possible. ODRC owns a First Aid Kit (Human) and will have this available at all events. But we do also have First Responders on site as well.
- If anyone sees a potential hazard then please report this immediately to a member of the committee.
